Plenary meeting: Smart regulation of the taxi services market

In February 2019 in his address to the Federal Assembly President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin set the task of radically revising the mandatory requirements that entrepreneurs must comply with in their activities. As of today, many of the mandatory requirements in the field of transport are outdated and have not been revised for more than 20 years. Since 2014 the professional community of the Russian taxi services market is waiting for the adoption of a conceptually new law "On taxi services." In some entities, the competent authorities exercise no control over the taxi services market altogether in anticipation of the "new powers" that the new law would give them.

Governments of many countries are looking for the most efficient measures to address the socio-economic challenges in the taxi services market. The range of such measures includes a certain set of regulatory tools, the right combination and balance of which determines the real effect, including taxi orders data management, licensing and recognition of IT-companies that provide taxi services to be a partner in the provision of transport services, prevention of road accidents, taxation, preferences, etc.

The task of the plenary session is to develop specific solutions for the smart regulation of the taxi services market, which should be efficient in terms of taxi business development and provision of quality services to passengers.
